The Bags:

Be sure to bring your DeBerry Farm "cube-shaped" bag to turn it in. If you still have your blue bag we gave you to carry corn in, bring it with you and you can put your share in there. If not, we'll give you another to use and keep.

If you forget to turn in your bag, just drop it off at the farm house sometime. You can leave it on the porch (go up the ramp) near where you picked up your produce.

Missed Weeks?

If you missed a week and didn't have anyone else pick up for you, you can stop by the farmers market in Oakland on Wednesdays from 10 am to 1 pm to pick up a replacement share.
